For Dr. David Celella, DVM and owner of the Rockwall Equine Center, in Terrell, Texas, working with horses is a lifelong labor of love. "I grew up with horses, and there was no question that I would pursue a career centered around on them. I went into veterinary medicine with that in mind," he explains.

About 35 years ago, he joined a veterinary practice in the Rockwall area of Texas that combined care for large and small animals. "After about a year and a half, I purchased the equine part of the practice and moved it to Terrell." The Rockwall Equine Center, opened in 1992, now offers a 9,000 sq. ft. temperature-controlled equine hospital with 14 hospital stalls, two isolation and quarantine stalls, and a surgical suite.

The equine center provides a comprehensive range of care services for horses, including digital radiography. "Horses pose some significant challenges when it comes to imaging and X-rays. They are large, powerful animals that are difficult to keep still. So, for example, if you are using a solution with wires or cords, these can get tangled in the horse's legs, which can be disastrous. And overall, you need to be able to get the imaging completed very quickly," Dr. Celella highlights.

## Transforming equine imaging

During his decades of equine care, Dr. Celella has seen true revolutions in imaging. "We've moved from old dip tanks to digital radiography, and now to Agfa Radiology Solutions' wireless systems." The MUSICA® image processing has been transformative, delivering exceptional image contrast while maintaining soft tissue clarity. "Every vet has their own preferences for what they want images to look like. I like a lot of contrast because it enables me to see the little details. MUSICA® provides clarity and contrast even for difficult areas such as the navicular bone, neck and back."

He adds, "It also allows us to see more soft tissue than we could before, which makes interpreting the images easier. In fact, you can even see the hairs on the horses' legs with the Agfa Radiology Solutions system." He highlights a notable case where this clarity enhanced diagnostic

capability. "A horse came in with a wound above the knee. Because the horse's lameness seemed extreme based on just the wound itself, we decided to do an X-ray to rule out a foreign body. Instead, with the Agfa system, we immediately spotted a faint line in the bone. Because of this, we did additional imaging a bit higher up, and found multiple fractures in the horse's radius. The initial line would not have been visible with our older systems."

The high quality of the images also enhances the reputation of the equine center. "Sometimes, we need to send images to other veterinarians. It's comforting to know that the good quality images we send reflect well on us, enhancing our credibility. We had a case involving a chest image that went through two referral veterinarians. One was so amazed at the image quality that he called the other to ask what system we were using to get that quality. That was very reassuring for us to hear," he recalls.

doesn't have to determine how to flip the image for certain views. "Before, we'd have to interrupt a study to swap the image so we could look at it, or keep someone at the computer to handle this. Now, the system automatically orients the images correctly, the first time."


He adds, "Just this morning, we had a horse with a founder (laminitis) that could not put weight on the leg, so the angle at which we were imaging was not a typical angle. We did not believe that the SmartRotate™ could determine to rotate the image 45 degrees, but it did and oriented the image correctly."

Depending on the situation, horses may be imaged in the hospital or in the stalls, so the X-ray system is used part of the day outside of the main building. "With our previous system, the battery often died in the middle of a study, so we had to bring the charging cord with us. Now, we keep the Agfa detector in the charger until we need it, then take it along for our studies, and it has never run out of power on us. We could bring the charger with us, for example if we knew we would be making multiple big studies, but we haven't needed to do this so far."

## Tailored for equine care

In equine radiology, DR detectors are essential for capturing clear X-ray images quickly and effectively. Duraline™ XD detectors come in different sizes to meet various imaging needs. "That's important, because while you might think 'the bigger the better', when you're working with a potentially dangerous animal, you don't want to risk the technician dropping the detector because it is too heavy or bulky. So, it needs to be light, as well. Our XD detector is just big enough to get the images that we need-the standard images-and no bigger."
